

Opening Circle

5-15min

Grounds the Group & Sets the Tone for the Day

- Mindfulness/Meditation
- Check Ins
- Games

Share Artistic Expertise

5-15min

Connects the Group to the larger Art World & Provides a Context for Art Making

- Examples of Inspiring Artists
- Historical & Cultural Background
 - Related Vocabulary to Art Form
- Teaching Artist Demonstrates Rigorous Arts Technique

Engage in Creative Process

25-45min

Moves Emerging Artists towards Mastery & Culminating Experience

- Technique Practice and Application
- Teaching Artist Serves as Mentor, Co-Creator, and Director
- Emerging Artists Share their Work, Receive Feedback, and Make Revisions

Closing Circle

5-15min

Provides Time for Reflection on Learning & Group Experience

- Self/Group Assessment
- Group Check Outs/Appreciations

Culminating Performance

Final Day

An opportunity to showcase what students learned and created in front of an audience of their peers and/or community

- Performance should mirror how professional artists share work: gallery for visual arts, stage/outdoor space for theater/music/dance
- Display additional photos and/or narrative describing the creative process alongside the performance
